### THEME

(The Sermon In a Sentence or Two)

Everyday faith is a reality intended for every believer.

### APPLICATION

(What to Do with What You Hear)

Cultivate your commitment to & awareness of your faith in God every day.

### FOCUS

(The Core of the Content to Get Us Started)

There’s a great deal of truth in the statement, “how it is you see determines what it is you see.” When it comes to faith we could say, “the way you believe influences how you believe which in turn determines what you believe especially as it pertains to God to His promises, provision & peace.”

## Everyday Faith ...

### 1. SHOULD be EVIDENT EVERY DAY.

Since we only get life one day at a time, each day’s the best day for it.

### 2. is SIMPLE & SINCERE choosing TRUST over FEAR.

Its simplicity & sincerity is often missed in our tendency to overcomplicate things ... “*paralysis through analysis*” is a very real problem, malady & foe.

### 3. is the OVERFLOW of CONFIDENCE in GOD & the UNWAVERING BELIEF that His WORD is TRUE.

Again, it’s not “I’ll believe it when I see it,” it is “I’ll see it when I believe it.”
