THEME / (The Sermon In a Sentence or Two)

God's kingdom is unshakeable & its King is unchanging.

APPLICATION / (What to Do with What You Hear)

Be sure you give your all for what can only be seen with the eyes of your heart.

FOCUS / (The Core of the Content to Get Us Started)

"Turn your eyes upon Jesus, look full in His wonderful face; and the things of earth will grow strangely in the light of His glory and grace." That's an old chorus that we probably ought to sing more than we do. It puts things in perspective. It calls us to Who & what matters most & lasts forever. We'd do well to connect with Him & that on a more regular basis :-)

Let's commit to elevate & express God's kingdom. Let's be sure to keep praising & proclaiming its King who is Jesus.

What to Do In Light of the Kingdom of God ...

1. Remember it STANDS ALONE & FOREVER as a SPIRITUAL reality that becomes EVIDENT in the PHYSICAL world through THOSE who are IN IT.
Every other kingdom is flawed & will fall. This one alone is unshakeable & eternal.
Hebrews 12:18-29
2. PROCLAIM & CELEBRATE its KING.
You can't have a kingdom without a king. This one's is the King of kings.
Hebrews 13:8
3. Live in the RECKLESS CONFIDENCE He & it PROVIDE.
We don't need to cower. We can & should stand strong & sure.
2 Timothy 1:11-13
4. Keep making the KINGDOM your PRIMARY PURSUIT.
Any pursuit in its place is ultimately an expression of ignorance & idolatry.
Matthew 6:33 (Matthew 13:44-45)

Making It Real Questions

- * Are you sure this is true? If so, how are you seeking to express it?
- * Are you currently doing this on a regular basis? If not, will you begin to do it?
 - * What's your confidence level in God's Kingdom & its King?
 - * Will you freshly commit to this in light of this morning's message?
